# 1 The new trick

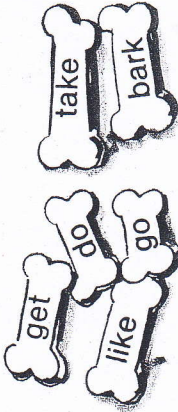

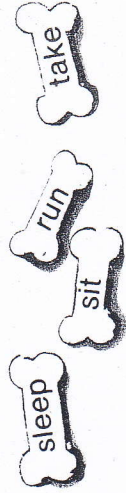
