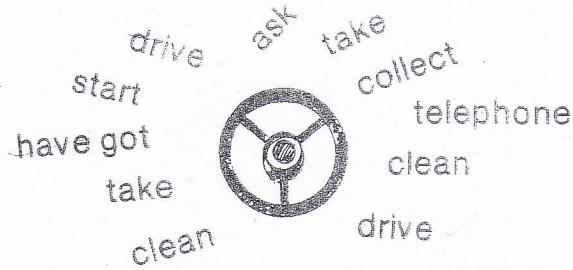
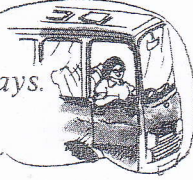


2 The bus driver

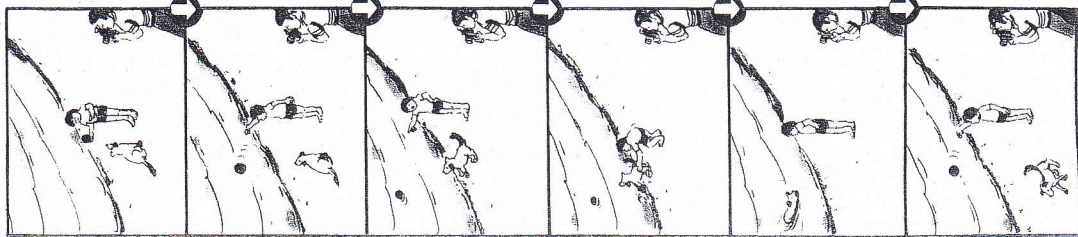

1 The new trick

a) A boy wants to teach his dog a new trick.

them. He barks at the neighbours. And he sometimes barks

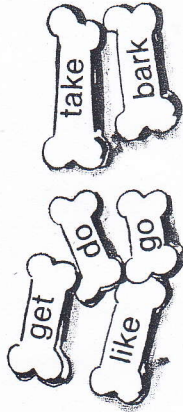
at night, too, and wakes Dad and me up.

That's good.

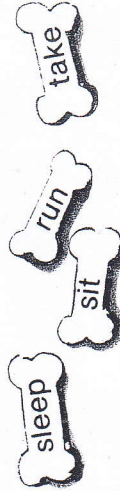


Mrs Wilson: Perhaps. But he is often a very bad dog. When I take him for a walk in
