Catchy Title Introduction

- you tell your reader briefly what your text is about; in a report what happened
- you arouse the reader's interest in reading your text
- in a report it can answer the 5 Ws (What? Who? When? Where? Why?) and How?

Main body

- paragraphs
- topic sentences (tells the reader the main idea of the paragraph)
- after the topic sentence go into etail, give examples
- different adjectives (bright, fantastic, amazing)
 and adverbs (quietly, slowly ...) or actions
- time phrases (last week, tomorrow)
- linking words (and, but, because, so, thus, therefore, that's why)
- relative clauses (who, which, that, whose or contact clauses)

Conclusion

⇒ you can give your opinion, or end with and interesting or funny fact about the topic or you summarize your text with phrases like "All in all ..." "To put it in a nutshell ..." "To conclude ""In conclusion ..."
