Talking about a complex work

You are only allowed to use a slip of keywords! (single words, groups of words, blackboard, transparencies, power point, handout)

No sentences or short texts !!!

You'll have to talk about <u>how you made it</u>!

First- give a <u>preview</u> of what you want to talk about!

(I want to talk about ... today. First I'll speak about .../ Then I'll tell you something about .../ Last I'll talk to you about ...

Helpful tips: You can set up your talk tis way:

1. First steps

Here you can tell your listeners about:

When did you do it?
What subject / lesson?
What was your task?
Working time?
Resources? Aid? (Help?)
Kind of work? (alone, group work)

2. How I did it

Here you should tell the audience about:

Working steps?

(I started with.../ Then I .../ After that I .../ After finishing that I .../ Next I .../ Last I ...

Problems?

(pictures, headlines, drawing, font, scissors, glue, not the perfect pen, arranging pics and texts on the piece of paper, mistakes, finding information, no or not enough help from a partner, no idea for illustrating ...)

3. Results

At the end of your talk you talk to the audience about: What was the aim of my work?

(presentation, collecting/giving someone information, illustrating, ...)

Audience?

(classmates, other pupils, teachers, parents ...)

Feelings?

(being excited, nervous,...)

When/where? Grading?

(the mark you/your group got for your work)

Your point of view?

(interesting or boring job?, fun or not?, teachings for next job?, pleased or not?...)
